



# How far is the back panel of the distribution box

Meeting the electrical panel clearance code is one of the easiest ways to avoid inspection delays. The three-foot working depth gives you safe access for operation and maintenance while ...

Electrical panel clearance requirements are based on NEC Article 110.26. The space must be at least 30 inches wide, or the width of the panel, whichever is greater. The NEC does not ...

The panel also needs to have a vertical clear space extending from the floor to a height of 6.5 feet or to the height of the equipment, whichever is greater. This way there is enough room to access it without ...

An example is a 30-foot-high ceiling in a warehouse, with the electrical panel located on an exterior wall. The panel is mounted 6 feet above the floor.

The distance between each panel will depend on the length of the wall, but you should aim for a benchmark of between 500-600mm. This should give enough space to allow for variations ...

Clearance: Electrical panels must be installed in a readily accessible area with a minimum clearance of 30 inches (762 mm) wide, 3 ft (36 inches or 914 mm) deep, and 6.5 feet (? 2 meter) high in front of ...

Looks like 1.5" EMT so that would mean that the distance between the raceways need to be a minimum of 9". This allows for the conductors to be installed without damaging them.

In homes, clearance for panelboards in basements, garages, or utility rooms must adhere to the 3-foot minimum front clearance. This applies even if the panel is located in a closet or ...
