Please help me with the process on how I can remove an IP from an existing VLAN on a cisco switch?

Solution Use "ip address none". The IP address none command clears the currently assigned IPv4 address and sets the IP address configuration method to none.

At my company we have a G3G124 core switch that's been running for a really long time and the person that set the system up is long gone, so I got tasked to change the DHCP settings.

If both Vlan1 and Vlan30 have an IP address, I can telnet into the switch using either IP address. When I remove Vlan1 IP, I can no longer telnet or ping the Vlan30 IP.
