



Should cable trays use cable identification tags

If trenches contain only one row of cable tray, it is acceptable to have access to the cable tray from the ground level without the need for an excavated access space along the cable tray path.

The choice of method should be discussed with a local inspector. The best decision may be to extend only the cables, creating a discontinuity in the cable tray.

Labels shall be placed on both side rails where visible on all cable tray segments throughout the plant. Where cable trays contain a barrier with different cable systems on each side the side rail should ...

The best way to label and identify cables for easier maintenance is to use a transparent, consistent labelling system that combines printed cable labels with matching identifiers on ...

Verify that cables are properly secured with suitable ties or clamps and that identification labels remain legible. Remove abandoned or out-of-service cables where possible to free space and ...

When cable trays contain conductors rated over 600 volts they are required to be marked "DANGER -- HIGH VOLTAGE -- KEEP AWAY" at no further than 10-foot intervals. That hasn't changed. What ...
