

# Switch aggregation port failure

Port aggregation allows you to group multiple physical ports into one unit. Port aggregation is useful for implementing load balancing and provides a redundant link backup. To allow port aggregation, the ...

Link aggregation can also provide redundancy; if one link is broken, the connection is still maintained by the other. It is also often cost-effective; a four-port Gigabit Ethernet card might not ...

If the member port is down, check the physical port connection. Make sure the member is up. If conditions permit, replace other member ports, confirm whether the aggregation member port can be ...

Port aggregation is not supported on most UniFi Gateways; it is only supported on the EFG, UXG Enterprise, UDM Pro, UDM SE and UDM Pro Max. Because of this, you should not aggregate two ...

If the Link Aggregation remains on this status for longer than one minute, verify that the switch is correctly configured. For instance, you should verify that LACP is enabled on the ports.

Troubleshooting: When LACP (Link Aggregation Control Protocol) or static LAG (Link Aggregation Group) is not functioning properly, common troubleshooting steps and checkpoints ...

If one physical port is lost for any reason (a cable is unplugged or a switch port fails), the logical port transparently continues to function over the remaining physical port.
