

# What color is best for a network server rack

What is the standard size of a data center rack? -> Typically 19-inch width, 42U height, 600-1200mm depth.  
What lighting is best for rack aisles? -> SeamLine Batten and SquareBeam ...

It would be great to be more granular and be able to use other colors for say uplinks / out of rack links but you have to have a very disciplined implementation team on the physical plant.
