

What is a counter

Counter is a sequential circuit. A digital circuit which is used for a counting pulses is known counter. Counter is the widest application of flip-flops. It is a group of flip-flops with a clock signal applied.

A digital counter is a finite state machine in which the counter's flip-flops serve as the state register. The value stored in the state register is a bit vector comprising the counter's current state.
