

# What is used to secure cables inside vertical cable trays

Cable trays must be adequately supported to carry the weight of cables plus any additional loads (such as snow or ice for outdoor installations). Use supports (wall brackets, trapeze ...

Secure cables to vertical trays using clamps and use ties for horizontal trays. Avoid overlapping cables in the trays to prevent pressure and potential damage to the cable insulation.
